1 READ THE TEXT

Andy Warhol was born and raised in Pittsburgh, America, in a family of Rusyn immigrants. In the 1950s, he first became successful as a commercial illustrator, making images for advertising and design.

After showing his artwork in galleries, Warhol became recognised in the 1960s as an influential and controversial artist. His New York studio, called The Factory, became a famous meeting place for many different kinds of people, including artists, writers, performers, celebrities, wealthy patrons and people from alternative communities.

Warhol also directed and produced underground films featuring people known as Warhol superstars. He is connected to the famous idea of '15 minutes of fame', meaning that anyone can become famous, even briefly. Warhol also managed and produced the experimental rock band The Velvet Underground.

Warhol expressed his queer identity through many of his artworks at a time when homosexuality was actively suppressed in the United States.
